

Humanities - Concentration Requirement

HUM students who want to have a Concentration should select 21 units from group A, B or C. They can utilize 3 units of their free elective units + 18 units of their major electives to meet up the 21 units Concentration requirement set by the university. The balance of the 6 units (24 units - 18 units) of their major electives should go to one course in each of the other two groups for the purpose of broadening their study horizons. Students who do not opt for a Concentration will choose at least two courses in the three groups and come up with 24 units as their major electives.
